## Backpack Buddies

Backpack Buddies for the Lake Road Head Start has begun! The first food distribution was Jan. 24. The other dates for this school year are: Feb. 28, Mar. 20, Apr. 24, May 22, and June 26.

At this time, we are supplying one bag of food for each of the 20 families every month containing: a small bag of snacks, a box of cereal (alternating dry cereal and instant oatmeal), canned or fresh fruit, and items for either a lunch or dinner meal. We are trying to keep the cost to about \$10.00 worth of food each month.

We have specific food requests for February, March and April. At Donation Corner in the narthex, there are sign up sheets where you can volunteer to donate:

- fresh fruits or vegetables (packaged by you)
- spaghetti sauce seasoning packets
- cans of tuna
- saltine crackers
- canned peaches (15 ounce)
- canned green beans (15 ounce)

Stay with us after worship, when we will have an art project for everyone in the community to participate in, creating a vibrant meditation on love and prayer in this season of Lent.



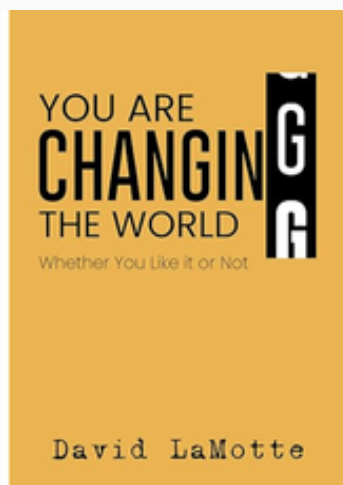
